## INSPIRE: Interactive Storytelling

"What If Trees Had Feelings" helps children express their feelings as they explore native and bush food trees



#### PLAY: Interactive Small group rotations

- 1. Build digital and movement skills by "growing" trees with interactive floor projections
- 2. Foster creative sensory play with trees, animals, Aboriginal dolls, and green sand



- 3. Express ideas about nature and people connections with Duplo trees, flowers and people
- 4. Develop fine motor skills by "growing" the giant floor tree and finding homes for native wildlife
