INSPIRE: Interactive storytelling

“What If Trees Had Feelings” helps children express their feelings as they explore native and bush food trees



PLAY: Interactive small group rotations

1. Build digital and movement skills by “growing” trees with interactive floor projections
2. Foster creative sensory play with trees, animals, Aboriginal dolls, and green sand
3. Express ideas about nature and people connections with Duplo trees, flowers and people
4. Develop fine motor skills by “growing” the giant floor tree and finding homes for native wildlife

* Note: Activity 4 will only be included for children over three years
