## INSPIRE: Interactive storytelling

“Bunny Bunny You’re So Funny” helps children explore sharing with the adventures of a cheeky bunny



## PLAY: Interactive small group rotations

1. Build digital and movement skills by “finding” the bunny with interactive floor projections
2. Foster creative sensory play with a world filled with wooden bunnies, trees and green sand
3. Explore sensory play and develop fine motor skills by “washing” ice bunnies in soapy suds
4. Explore sustainability and build fine motor skills by “repairing” the giant bunny

\* Note: Activity 4 will only be included for children over three years
